- Administration Modification Change: Per new GDOT regulations, any non-federal phase can be administratively modified
- Reports:
 - City of Rome: Chris reported that city paved 7 miles in 2024 with LMIG funds, new GDOT funding, LRA, will provide \$600K for paving. 2017 SPLOST awarded \$1.9M for paving infrastructure
 - Floyd County: Michael reported: Floyd County has 29.5 miles scheduled for paving this year. 4.5 are a carryover from previous years, plus 25 miles newly funded.
 - We will be outsourcing a project to pave Rush Chapel Road (2.7 miles) with a Rubber Modified Asphalt mix, partially funded by the EPD.
 - Working on plans to continue work in Lindale and Riverside with Infrastructure Splost funds

- **0004915 SR 140 FM SR 53/FLOYD TO 0.3 MI W OF OOTHKALOOGA CRK/BARTOW** Widening and Reconstruction Project
 - Contractor (G.P.'S ENTERPRISES, INC.) shifted traffic to newly constructed Westbound lanes at Wall 2 (across from Old Hwy 140). Removing and reconstructing existing Lanes in this area. Current Completion Date: 5/31/2025. 97% Complete.
- **0013937 SR 1/US 27 @ BIG DRY CREEK/OOSTANAULA RIVER IN ROME** (At Berry 11College)
 - Contract awarded to C.W. Matthews. Traffic shifted to SB lanes in June 2024. NB lanes of existing bridge have been removed. Anticipated Completion: 3/31/2026. 50% Complete.

- **0015544 FLOYD, SR 293 @ DYKES CREEK** Bridge Replacement
 - Subcontractor constructing temporary detour bridge for traffic shift prior to existing bridge demolition.
 - Anticipated Completion Date: 12/31/2025. 40% Complete.
- **0019285 FLOYD, SR 1 FM CEDAR AVE TO E 2ND AVE & SR 20 FM SR 1 TO CHATEAU DR** Guardrail Improvements
 - Contractor removing and replacing guardrail per construction plans. Anticipated Completion Date was: 10/31/24. 83% Complete.
- **0016611 - CR 924/BELLS FERRY ROAD @ WOODWARD CREEK**
 - This project is the replacement of the bridge on CR 924/Bells Ferry Road at Woodward Creek. Anticipated Let Date: 12/19/2025
- **650540- FLOYD, SR 101/2nd Ave** Widening and Reconstruction
 - Anticipated completion date: 10/15/26. Storm drain and water line complete. 23% complete.
- **0013690 - PEDESTRIAN UPGRADES @ 19 LOCS IN FLOYD COUNTY**
 - The project proposes pedestrian upgrades at 14 locations in Floyd County. The project will improve pedestrian mobility at each intersection by adding and/or upgrading pedestrian related infrastructure and equipment and bringing the intersections up to ADA standards. Pedestrian related upgrades include crosswalks, pedestrian signs, pedestrian signal heads and pushbuttons, pedestrian related cabinet equipment, ADA compliant ramps, and refuge islands. This project will also install the FYA signal heads, backplates and strain poles. Anticipated Let Date: 8/15/2026
- **M006263 FLOYD/SR 20 (US 411) over SR 1 (US 27)** Bridge Rehab
 - Let Date: 7/21/2023. Anticipated Completion: 4/21/2025. 87% complete.

 - Work began 8/11/24 resurfacing SR 1 Loop. Anticipated completion date: 1/31/2025. 93% complete.
- **M006378 FLOYD/WALKER, Bridge Rehab at Various Locations** in Floyd and Walker Counties.
 - Polymer Overlay, Painting of the steel beams and replacement of bridge joints. Let Date: 8/18/2023. Anticipated Completion 10/31/2024. 99% complete.
 - Floyd County locations - SR 1 - US 27 (NBL & SBL) over Silver Creek. SR 1 - US 27 (NBL & SBL) over Southern R/ R. SR 53 (EBL & WBL) over Southern Railroad. And SR 101 over SR 1 - US 27.
- **M006202- SR 1;SR 2;SR 3;SR 20 & SR 286 @ 8 LOCS - BRIDGE PRESERVATION**
 - Current Completion Date: 1/31/2026. 11% complete.
 - Project Description: Applying a polymer overlay and replacing joints. The bridge preservation work will take place on eight (8), State Route bridges in Catoosa, Floyd and Whitfield Counties. *Bridge ID 115-0018-0 Floyd County SR 1- US 27 over Oostanaula River.*
