A Resolution by the Rome-Floyd Metropolitan Planning Organization and the Transportation Policy Committee Adopting the 2024 Title VI Environmental Justice Analysis

WHEREAS, the Rome-Floyd Metropolitan Planning Organization (RFMPO) has been designated by the Governor of the State of Georgia as the body responsible for the transportation planning process for Rome-Floyd County.

WHEREAS, the federal regulations, infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), mandate that Metropolitan Planning Organizations develop a Title VI Program and Environmental Justice Analysis; and

WHEREAS, as a sub-recipient of federal funds from the Federal Highway Administration (FHA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) via the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT), the RFMPO is required to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 which prohibits discrimination based on race, color, and national origin; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Policy Committee is the recognized decision making body for transportation planning with the RFMPO; and

NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Rome-Floyd MPO adopts the 2025 Title VI Environmental Justice Analysis.

A motion was made by TPC member Chris Jenkins and seconded by Michael Skeen and approved on November 20, 2024.
